

ELLIOT LAKE'S BY LAWS

LICENSING

The city requires all dogs and cats to be registered by their owners and the information should be maintained in case your pet gets lost. A valid rabies vaccination certificate is required before a license will be issued. Dogs are required to be on a leash whenever they are off your property license tags should be attached to their collar.

LICENSE FEES*

Before January 15 (fixed/not fixed)

Cats - 15\$/25\$ Dogs - 20\$/30\$

After January 15 (fixed/not fixed)

Cats - 25\$/50\$ Dogs - 35\$/60\$

STOOP 'N SCOOP

The city requires that the owner pick up pet waste immediately, garbage containers are provided on the most popular routes.

PET BOARDING

For dogs: We have a fairly large built in kennel offering inside and outside access. If your dog gets along with others we have 3 large exercise areas where they can run and play.

For cats: We have a boarding room where they can roam about the general population of cats at the shelter. We also have large kennels that our boarders enjoy.

Before boarding we must see proof of your pets vaccinations are up to date. It is best to book your pet a early as possible as we often fill up the spots, especially during the holidays. Our office is closed on the weekend but staff come in to look after animals.

Day - 10\$ | Week - 60\$ \1 cat and 90\$ \2 cats

Dogs

Day - 15\$ | Week - 90\$ \1 dog and 120\$ \2 dogs

DAYCARE*

We have a limited number of openings for dogs. We are here from 8 AM to 4 PM each week day. Day care is not available on weekends. The cost is only 10\$ per day.

ADOPTION FEES*

Cat or Kitten - 78.30\$ + GST > 90.00\$

Dog or Puppy - 174.80\$ +GST > 190.00\$

Fees include spay/neuter and all necessary vaccines but not a license.

FOSTER HOMES

A BRIEF HISTORY OF SAD

S.A.D. was founded on April 1971 in Toronto by Mr. Alan McGinn. He started the society in response to the Animals for Research Act which allowed stray animals in pounds and humane societies to be seized within three days for research and medical purposes. He felt there was a genuine need for an animal shelter in Northern Ontario and chose Elliot Lake from three possible locations. S.A.D. in Elliot Lake was born from this in 1995. Sadly, Mr. McGinn passed away in February 2000 but we continue his work in his honor.
